Dear Future Partner,

The Sándor Ferenczi Society has the opportunity to establish the Ferenczi Museum, Archive and Library by buying an apartment in the former home of Sándor Ferenczi. During the last years of his life, Ferenczi worked on Naphegy (Sun Hill) in District I of Budapest receiving both his patients and disciples there. Many of these disciples went on to spread his innovative teachings abroad. It was also here where he wrote his most influential works on modern psychoanalysis.

The Ferenczi House would function as a museum, archive and library presenting the life and work of Ferenczi and the Budapest School of Psychoanalysis. It would also serve as a research, training and therapeutic centre opening its doors to both Hungarian and foreign professionals and visitors alike. Ferenczi and Hungarian psychoanalysis made significant contributions to the development of modern psychotherapy, thereby greatly contributing to the recognition of 20th century Hungarian cultural history in Europe and overseas.

Our aim is to complete the Ferenczi Centre by 2008, for the 100th anniversary of the meeting of Freud and Ferenczi.

Since November 1, 2005, our Society has rented an apartment, of 47 square metres, in Ferenczi's former villa on Naphegy, which is now for sale for 20 million HUF/80.000 Euro/100.000 USD. Unless we are able to raise this sum and purchase the flat before July, 2006 we lose the opportunity of buying it. The purchase of this apartment would represent the cornerstone in establishing the Ferenczi Center and secure the opportunity to fully realize the vision of this center.

Sándor Ferenczi's importance in the world of psychotherapy is comparable to Béla Bartók's in the world of music. His therapeutic methods may be found throughout the world.


